Nearly 100 pairs of shoes donated!

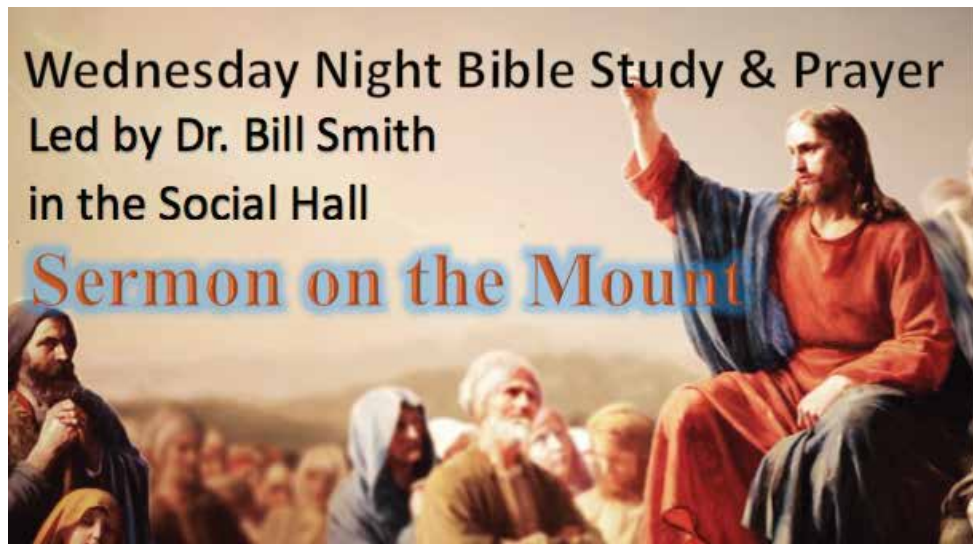

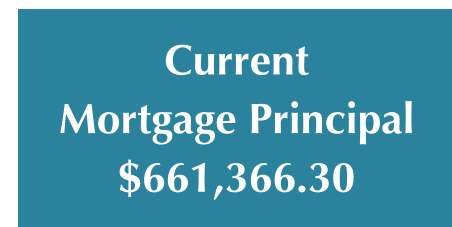
