




Wednesday Nights In May and June

Background Checks

Our church is in the process of collecting background checks for all adults who are volunteering to serve in the Preschool, Children and Youth ministries of our church. We are seeking to be faithful in securing the best environment for ministry to our children and youth and in doing that we require effective August 1, 2019 that everyone who serves in these areas submit the background check forms.

In that we are screening for sexual and violent offenses. We are not looking at credit scores or other areas of a person's private life. The background check forms will be turned in to our secretary. She will run the forms and keep the returns in a locked file. The ministry staff and other leaders in the church will not see the forms. They will only be aware of who is approved on the list for people to serve. Thank you for understanding the need to implement this policy as we seek to secure as safe of an environment for our children as possible.


